



CERTIFICATE

ORDEM DOS ENGENHEIROS (OE), is the Portuguese national public institution of professional engineers. In Portugal the engineering profession is regulated by law. Under Portuguese law, and namely the provisions of Decree-Law no. 119/92, of 30th June 1992, OE is duly empowered to attribute the title of Engineer and regulates the practice of the engineering profession.

Under the provisions of Law no. 9/2009, of 4 March 2009, which transposes Directive no. 2005/36/CE, of 7 September 2005, of the Parliament and the Council, and the provisions of the same Directive relative to a system of recognition of professional qualifications, the aforementioned ORDEM is empowered as Portugal's COMPETENT AUTHORITY to the effect.

Therefore, in my capacity as Secretary General of ORDEM DOS ENGENHEIROS, competent authority for the engineering profession in Portugal, hereby CERTIFY, at his own request and in order to practice the (ESPECIALIDADE) Engineering profession in (PAÍS), that Mr. (NOME) obtained a 5 year degree in (ESPECIALIDADE) Engineering and is an Effective Member of Portugal's ORDEM DOS ENGENHEIROS since (DATA MEMBRO EFETIVO), with the Senior¹ Level of Qualification and is a Specialist² in (ESPECIALIZAÇÃO-ING) (ESPECIALIZAÇÃO-PT). He is licensed to practice (ESPECIALIDADE) Engineering in Portugal, holder of Professional License no. (N.º CÉDULA).

According to the ORDEM records, nothing is held against Mr. (NOME)'s professional conduct in the practice of his profession and there are no disciplinary sanctions against him on record.

I further CERTIFY that the (ESPECIALIDADE) Engineering profession is a regulated activity in Portugal, and that, by law, the attribution of the respective professional title and the regulation and disciplinary control of the practice of the engineering profession fall under the jurisdiction of the ORDEM, which is the profession's regulatory authority.

Mr. (NOME) is certified to practice the (ESPECIALIDADE) Engineering as a profession in compliance with all requirements as set out under the provisions of Directives 2005/36/CE for purposes of practicing Civil Engineering as a profession in the European Union.

¹ The Senior Member Level of Qualification is attributed to engineers with over 5 years of professional experience, who have shown maturity in the exercise of their profession, portraying autonomy and coordination and/or leadership capabilities. Access to this Level of Qualification requires a higher education of at least 5 years.

² The title of Specialist is attributed to engineers with over 10 years of professional experience within an area of technical and scientific importance and one with its own methodology, to whom such competence is recognized.
